I experienced multiple placements, which came with different cultural experiences, school changes, family problems, group homes etc. Each place had its own set of challenges that I had to overcome and I learned resiliency throughout my journey.

Years later, I graduated high school and went on to UK (University of Kentucky) for college and ended up dropping out my first year. From there I worked retail for a year and learned about the daily grind of life and decided what I wanted more. I went to BCTC (Bluegrass Community and Technical College) and then eventually EKU (Eastern Kentucky University) where I graduated with my Bachelors in Communications/Broadcasting and Electronic Media.

After graduating, I started working in radio and in different advocacy roles for foster youth. Throughout this part of my journey, I started gaining more experience in speaking and emceeing events by reconnecting with some of the different people I met throughout my time in foster care.

Currently I am working in mental health and social work, learning about different disabilities and relating to youth using my infectious personality and down-to-earth demeanor. My humor is a rich and valuable trait that has sustained me during the tough times. I have been invited by different conferences both in and out of state either as a keynote, participant, observer, or panel member and I am always on the mission to encourage and empower other youth, parents, and providers. I have served on several boards and partnered with several organizations to build community. Wherever I go, I am on a mission to be a voice for the voiceless.
