Thursday, January 30, 2020

Special Education Law (IDEA & 504)

This session will explain Special Education Law including the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Part B (ages 3- 21) regarding Individualized Education Program (IEP) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act regarding 504 Plan.
