### **2/16/23 Session 1: IEP Team Who's a Member?**

Looks, person by person, at the membership of the team of individuals that IDEA requires be involved in developing a child's individualized education program (IEP).

### **2/23/23 Session 2: Contents of the IEP**

Looks in detail at the information that must be included in the IEP of every child with a disability receiving special education and related services under IDEA.

### **3/2/23 Session 3: Meetings of the ARC/IEP Team**

Focuses on what happens in the meeting, where the IEP gets written, who's there, what's discussed, and what must be considered.

### **3/9/23 Session 4: Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) Decision Making**

Pivots on a point of enormous importance in the educations of children with disabilities under IDEA: They are to be educated in the least restrictive environment (LRE), learning and working alongside their peers without disabilities to the maximum extent appropriate.
