Luckily, they can get support. Check out three different kinds of supports below, and explore which one may be right for you!

Supported Decision Making

A Non-Legal (in Kentucky) agreement where an individual with disabilities makes their own decisions with support.



Guardianship

A legal agreement that allows one person to make personal and/or financial decisions for another person.



Conservatorship

A legal agreement that allows one person to make only financial decisions for another person.
